- **MANAGER'S REPORT:** CA: -- Eric has been painting the bridge tower and is almost done. The creek is now low enough so that the equipment can be carried across and brought up through the State Park.
 - The generator for the treatment plant has been ordered and paid for. The slab needs to be poured. The electrician Jesse Tidwell will do the connection.
 - CA is still working on finding the right generator for the well.
 - Monthly report and samples have been done and sent it.
 - Rio has been doing a lot of work on the electronic monitoring system at the treatment plant. He has been consulting with E&M and creating a workflow for the treatment plant. CA and RR have been working on making the data available for the monthly reports. Two more channels are possible for PH and temperature.
 - -- A lot of chemical tests are due in June.
 - -- The annual report and the Consumer Confidence report are due on July 1.
 - **B.** Harbor House project/ Emergency plan for sewer line: CA: CA still needs to meet with the contractor and manager to make sure everything is monitoring correctly, and we can create the emergency plan.
 - D. Greenwood Commons/ draft agreement/update: CA: CA spoke to Terry Gross today. The biggest challenge is to get the partners (far flung across the globe) into a position to sign off. She advised to enlist Redwood Title to clarify how the title is held and how to sign it over. M/ DG to authorize the necessary expenses for Redwood Title to be assumed by the District in order to complete the transfer of the property of Greenwood Commons to ECWD. S/JP, unanimous vote.
 - **E**. Back-up power for treatment plant and one-phase pump for well #1/update: CA: A 14 kw generator has been ordered and paid for. The generator for the well is still being researched.
